Tamasaki Shrine Empowers Worshippers

The primary shrine (Ichinomiya) of the Kazusa region. from which the name of the town derived, Tamasaki Shrine is a prestigious religious facility with a history of over 1,200 years. Having been worshipped by many people since old days, the shrine has an energizing atmosphere in its precinct. Visit the shrine to receive power.

Kazusanokuni Ichinomiya **Tamasaki Shrine**

Located at the southernmost end of the Kujukurihama beach in Sotobo, Ichinomiya Town is blessed with a warm climate all year round and said to have been inhabited by people since as far back as the Jomon and Yayoi periods. Tamasaki Shrine, built in this historic place, is an ancient religious facility in Kazusanokuni. Its name appears in Jinmeicho (a list of deities) of Engishiki (a book of laws and regulations) compiled in the early Heian period. Since then, it has been regarded as one of the most prestigious shrines in the nation and worshipped as Kazusanokuni Ichinomiya by many people including members of the imperial court, local ruling clans and feudal governments.

The enshrined deity is Tamavorihime-no-mikoto, the mother of the first emperor, Jinmu. Famous for its protection of women since old days, the shrine is believed to offer blessings for marriage, conception, safe delivery and child rearing among others. Also, many worshippers who pray for good luck and busi-

ness prosperity are attracted to this shrine because it is at the place of the rising sun on the eastern point of the Sunrise Road (Lev Line) and said to be a power spot filled with a magnificent spiritual aura. The Kazusa-Junisha Festival, which takes place on September 13 every year, has the oldest history and tradition in the Boso Peninsula where many Shinto rituals are held in which portable shrines are brought to the beach. This festival is designated as an intangible cultural property by Chiba Prefecture.

The main hall of Tamasaki Shrine features a rare architecture, called Gongenzukuri, which is coated in black lacquer

Walk Around the Precinct

1.Sacred water

The sacred water, which bubbles up in the Tenno-manai (aka the Swan's Well), is believed to have some of the energy that fills the precinct and enhance people's luck. The water is available 24/7 for drinking and purification. Plastic bottles can be bought at the juyo-jo at 100 yen apiece.

2.Hadashi-no-michi Road

Walk barefoot on the road covered with white gravel clockwise three times, and you'll receive the power of the earth from the soles of your feet. It is said that the first walk-around purifies you, the second induces energy into your body and the third fills you up with energy, making your wishes come true.

3.Ginkgo for conception



Three ginkgo trees are lined up, the male on the right, the female on the left and its child in between. Touch the male tree, female tree and then the child tree, and pray for pregnancy. It is said that the shrine has received many letters from people who claim to have had children thanks to this ritual.

Sunrise Road - Lev Line

Tamasaki Shrine, located at the eastern edge of Japan, has a tradition of worship of the sun as its first gateway faces the east. According to recent claims, lined up on the extension of the line connecting Tamasaki Shrine and the position where the rising sun shines on the gateway on the day of

the spring and autumn equinox are Samukawa Shrine the summit of Mt. Fuii, Mt. Shichimen, Chikubu Island, Moto Ise Kotai-iingu Shrine where the inner shrine of Ise-jingu Shrine is believed to have been transferred Obgamiyama Shrine in Daisen, and Izumo-taisha Shrine. This line is known as the Sunrise Road (Ley Line). Tamasaki Shrine is the starting point in the east and one of the most famous power spots in the Kanto region.



Kazusa-Junisha Festival

100475-42-2711 (Kazusanokuni Ichinomiya Tamasaki Shrine)

Dating back to about 1,200 years ago, this Shinto ritual originated from a ceremony in which Tamavorihime-no-mikoto, the enshrined deity, reunites with the other deities of her clan once a year at Tsurigasaki Kaigan Square (MAPP10D4). People carrying 9 portable shrines, led by sacred horses, leave each individual shrine, gather at Tsurigasaki Kaigan Square, and then go back to the shrines. The festival is an intangible cultural heritage designated by the prefecture.

Olt takes a 7-minute walk from JR Kazusa-Ichinomiya Station to Tamasaki Shrine. Free shuttle bus service is available for those who go to Tsurigasaki Kaigan Square. Square S

A major highlight of the Setsubun Festival held on February 3 to get rid of evil spirits is the Ritual of Bows and Arrows, in which arrows made from reed are shot with a bow made from peach tree. Many worshippers also participate in the


Shunki Taisai Festival on April 12 and 13 during which performances such as Urayasu-no-mai Dance and Kazusa Kagura are presented. A must-see





